



Resident & Fellow Council Application

Program Overview

You physician members are the future of the association and the AANEM makes certain their needs and interests are heard at the top level of the organization. Being involved in AANEM is a great way to stay informed, learn new information, enhance your current skills, and connect with leaders in the NM, MSK, NMUS, and EDX medicine. The association hosts a forum to help members share knowledge and discuss important topics. AANEM also provides its members with exclusive educational materials, excellent conferences, and several leadership opportunities to help build your career.

The AANEM selects up to twelve members who are in a residency or fellowship program to serve 2 year terms on the Resident & Fellow Council. Members of the council attend the fall annual meeting as well as participate in other meetings of the council virtually throughout the year. Representation on the council will be split evenly between psychiatry and neurology members.

Eligibility Requirements

AANEM members in good standing are eligible to apply or be nominated. Resident and fellow member applicants must have been enrolled in a postgraduate training program in the calendar year when their council term begins. The term will begin in conjunction with the AANEM Annual Meeting.

Participation Requirements

Council members are required to attend and participate in the scheduled meetings, be an active AANEM Young Ambassador, and contribute to the tasks outlined in the current job description of the council.

Application Process

To apply, submit the following items, along with this application, to AANEM at membership@aanem.org.

- 500 word (maximum) personal statement of interest summarizing your qualifications and leadership skills
- Copy of your Curriculum Vitae
- A letter of recommendation from your Training Program Director or other AANEM physician member

Selection Process

All applications and nominations will be reviewed by the AANEM Membership Committee and a recommendation presented to the AANEM President for final selection. If the member nominated is from the President's institution, the President Elect will make the final determination.
